

Continuous Loop Technique

Step 1 - Form first loop

Leave approximately 3 inches of bare wire before beginning the loops. This gives you something to hold on to while you are working.



Form a loop of beads from the number of beads specified in the pattern

Twist the ends of the wire underneath the loop of beads one time (two twists for the first and last loop). Keep the twist snug against the loop of beads so the beads do not slip.

Step 2 - Form second loop

Slide another pattern repeat of beads to within 1/8 to 1/4 inch of the first loop. Create a second loop twisting the wire once underneath the beads.



The pattern will specify how many loops to make.

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
